NOTICE OF DAY OF REVIEW OF APPORTIONMENTS

(In accordance with P.A. 40, of 1956, as amended)

Notice is Hereby Given that on Thursday, August 31, 2017, the Ingham County Drain Commissioner and the Clinton County Drain Commissioner will hold a Day of Review of Apportionments from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Office of the Ingham County Drain Commissioner, 707 Buhl, Mason, Michigan 48854, and at the Office of the Clinton County Drain Commissioner, 100 E State Street, Suite 2300, St. Johns, Michigan 48879. At that time and at those places, the Drain Commissioners will hear the proofs and allegations and carefully reconsider and review the apportionment of benefits for assessment purposes. The Drain is located and established in the following municipalities:

Ingham County: City of Lansing, Sections 4, 5, and 6
Clinton County: Dewitt Township, Sections 19, 20, and 28-34

The Ingham County Drain Commissioner and Clinton County Drain Commissioner will have the tentative apportionments against parcels and municipalities within the Drainage District available to review. Drain assessments will be collected in the same manner as property taxes. If Drain assessments are to be collected in installments, they may be paid in full with any interest to date at any time to avoid further interest charges.

The entities to be assessed at large are as follows: Ingham County, City of Lansing, Clinton County, Dewitt Township; and, Michigan Department of Transportation.
