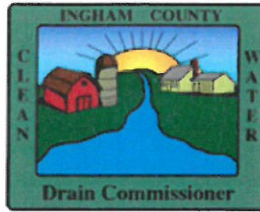

RE: Angel Acres Drain Public Scope Meeting

Dear Property Owner:

You are receiving this letter because you own property within the Angel Acres Drain Drainage District, which is located within Alaiedon Township.

As you may know, the Office of the Ingham County Drain Commissioner was petitioned for improvements to this Drain. A Board of Determination, held at Alaiedon Township Hall on March 15, 2018, found that improvements to the Drain were indeed necessary and conducive to the public health, convenience or welfare; and were necessary for the protection of the public health in Alaiedon Township.

Since the meeting of the Board of Determination, the Drainage District's engineer has been developing preliminary design concepts and preliminary cost ranges for the drain improvement project. I am writing to invite you to a public scope meeting to receive your input on the engineer's preliminary designs. **The meeting will be held on Thursday, February 21, 2019, at 6:30 p.m. at the Alaiedon Township Hall, 2021 Holt Road, Mason, Michigan, 48854.**

If you are unable to attend this meeting, or have any questions about it, please contact me or Project Coordinator Dave Solberg at (517) 719-4898 and we will be happy to discuss this matter with you anytime at your convenience.

This meeting will not discuss apportionment issues – who might pay how much of the project. You will receive a separate notice for a Day of Review where assessments will be discussed. That will occur after the scope of the project is decided and bids are received to allow an exact computation of cost of the project.
