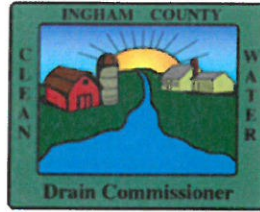

RE: Rayner Creek Drain Public Scope Meeting

Dear Property Owner:

You are receiving this letter because you own property within the Rayner Creek Drain Drainage District, which includes parts of Vevay Township and the City of Mason.

As you may know, the Office of the Ingham County Drain Commissioner was petitioned for improvements to this Drain. A Board of Determination, held at Vevay Township Hall on August 16, 2018, found that improvements to the Drain were indeed necessary and conducive to the public health, convenience or welfare; and were necessary for the protection of the public health in Vevay Township and the City of Mason.

Since the meeting of the Board of Determination, the Drainage District's engineer has been developing preliminary design concepts and preliminary cost ranges for the drain improvement project. I am writing to invite you to a public scope meeting to receive your input on the engineer's preliminary designs. **The meeting will be held on Thursday, January 31, 2019, at 6:30 p.m. at the Vevay Township Hall, 780 South Eden Road, Mason, Michigan, 48854.**

If you are unable to attend this meeting, or have any questions about it, please contact me or Project Coordinator Dave Solberg at (517) 719-4898 and we will be happy to discuss this matter with you anytime at your convenience.


